




REASONS FOR THE CYBER BULLYING – ERASMUS +


1. Cyber Bullies Are Motivated by Revenge

- -lacking attention and supervision from parents




4. Cyber Bullies Cave Under Peer Pressure

- -regularly harassing people online




6. Cyber Bullies Are Power Hungry
