The assumption made is that the words should end after a tile (or that there should be a space between the words).

ANYONE ANYHOW ANYWAY

The assumption is that all tiles have to be used and no tile may be used more than once

If you don't see the three words immediately its because you are making an assumption that the words are to be read from left to right. Try reading words vertically, from top to bottom

Assumption / To assume


Something that is taken for granted or accepted as true
