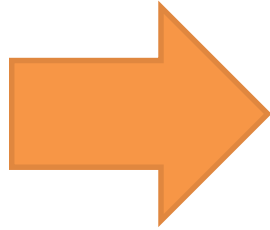




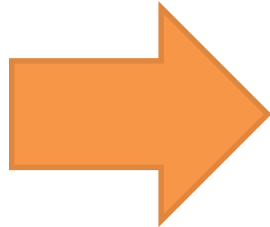

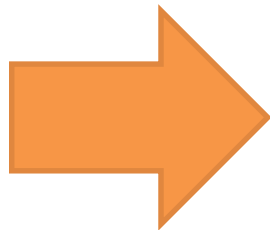
Three Goals



Students acquire job related knowledge



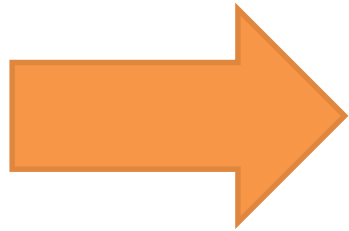
Students acquire academic knowledge



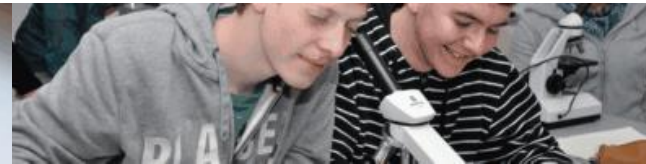
Students get an advanced technical college certificate = Fachabitur = FHR

Challenges

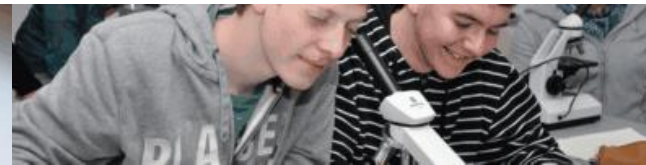
for students and teachers alike

4. Students feel tremendous psychological pressure if they are not able to academically keep up with their classmates.
5. Students increasingly have low reading abilities or are dyslexic.
6. Students increasingly have difficulties at home or don't live at home at all.

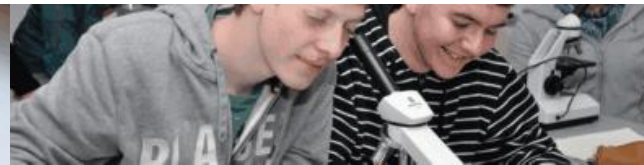

Obligatory in 11th grade:

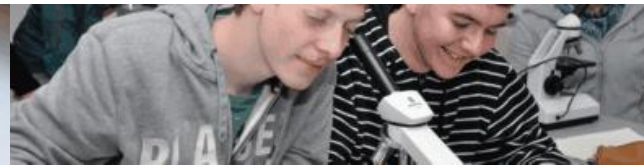
- Maths is taught 4 periods a week
